A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Notwithstanding the language of section (G) (2) SECTION 1. 2 of Schedule FIT Tier 1 and Tier 2 of the public utilities 3 commission docket No. 2008-0273, no electric utility shall be 4 excused from paying for power at the rates set forth in section 5 (G)(2) of Schedule FIT Tier 1 and Tier 2 on the basis that a copy of the seller's tax form was not received by the company 6 7 prior to the commercial operation date when it is not possible to complete the form prior to the commercial operation date. 8 9 For purposes of this Act: "Company" means the public utility purchasing power from 10

11 the seller, subject to the terms of Schedule FIT Tier 1 and Tier
12 2.

13 "Commercial operation date" means the date the seller 14 notifies the company that the energy-generating project is 15 operating and able to produce and deliver energy to the company 16 pursuant to the terms of Schedule FIT Tier 1 and Tier 2. 17 "Seller" means the seller of power.



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1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval; 2 provided that this Act shall be repealed on the earlier of June 30, 2015, or when the public utilities commission issues a 3 4 decision and order that supersedes section (G)(2) of Schedule 5 FIT Tier 1 and Tier 2 of the public utilities commission docket 6 No. 2008-0273.
