A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to allow home school students, who would otherwise be denied the opportunity to do so, to participate on an equal basis in extracurricular
