A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 302A-251, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "[4]§302A-251[4] School year; instructional time. (a)
4 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, for the 2011-2013
5 school years, all public schools, except charter schools[7] and
6 <u>multi-track public schools</u>, shall implement a school year of one
7 hundred eighty days, excluding professional development days and
8 other non-instructional days negotiated pursuant to chapter 89,
9 that shall include:

10 (1) Nine hundred fifteen student instructional hours for
11 the elementary school grades; and

12 (2) Nine hundred ninety student instructional hours for13 the secondary school grades.

(b) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, for the
2013-2015 school years, all public schools, except charter
schools[-] and multi-track public schools, shall implement a
school year of one hundred eighty days, excluding professional
development days and other non-instructional days negotiated
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1	pursuant to chapter 89, that shall include one thousand eighty		
2	student instructional hours for both elementary and secondary		
3	school grades.		
4	(c) Multi-track public schools shall implement a school		
5	year of no less than:		
6	(1) Either one hundred seventy-one days or per cent		
7	of the number of days required in other public		
8	schools, except charter schools, under subsections (a)		
9	and (b) for each respective school year, whichever		
10	number is greater; and		
11	(2) per cent of the number of student		
12	instructional hours required in other public schools,		
13	except charter schools, under subsections (a) and (b)		
14	for each respective school year.		
15	[(c)] <u>(d)</u> For purposes of this section, "student		
16	instructional hours" means student learning time during which		
17	students are engaged in learning activities including regularly-		
18	scheduled instruction and learning assessments within the		
19	curriculum, and does not include lunch, recess, or passing		
20	time."		
21	SECTION 2. Act 167, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, is		
22	amended by amending section 4 to read as follows:

Instructional Days; Multi Track Public Schools

Description:

Requires multi-track public schools to have a school year of at least 171 days or a specified percentage of the minimum days for other non-charter public schools and a certain percentage of the minimum student instructional hours. Requires DOE to submit to the legislature a plan to implement a school year for multitrack schools beginning with the 2015-2016 school year of a certain percentage of the minimum instructional days and hours required of other non-charter public schools. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)
