A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING A GRANT APPROPRIATION FOR THE HAWAII LIVESTOCK COOPERATIVE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the sustainable 2 development of Hawaii's meat processing facilities is vital for 3 Hawaii's residents and nearly seven million annual visitors. 4 The legislature also acknowledges that, as food safety concerns 5 and health alternatives weigh more heavily in consumers' food 6 purchasing decisions, it has become necessary to support a 7 statewide network of meat processing facilities with sustainable 8 business plans and continually emerging food safety procedures. 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds as a grant 10 to support the Hawaii Livestock Cooperative's continued 11 operations and its development of a sustainable business plan. 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,400,000 or so much 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 as a grant, pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to 15 16 support the Hawaii Livestock Cooperative's continued operations 17 and its development of a sustainable business plan.

The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
