7	condition	s, including cost, to properties that are located
8	outside o	f designated flood zones as is available to properties
9	located w	ithin designated flood zones; provided that the
10	property	located outside of a designated flood zone has
11	experienc	ed at least one documented flood:
12	(1)	That resulted in damages of at least \$ to
13		real or personal property;
14	(2)	That was catalyzed by a natural event; and
15	(3)	Where damage to real or personal property was
16		exacerbated by natural or man-made geographic or
17		topographical features, or infrastructure, that was



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1	not installed, maintained, or controlled by the owner
2	of the insured property.
3	(b) Nothing in this section shall preclude recovery by an
4	individual or an insurer from a person or entity, including a
5	state, county, or federal government department or agency, found
6	to be liable for damages to an insured property by reason of
7	that person's installation, ownership, maintenance, or control
8	of a geographic or topographical feature, or infrastructure."
