A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIAL SELECTION COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The judicial selection commission reviews and evaluates applicants for all judicial vacancies, selects the 2 3 qualified nominees, and then forwards the names of the nominees 4 to the appropriate appointing authority. The judicial selection 5 commission is an independent, constitutionally-created entity 6 and, pursuant to article VI, section 4, of the Constitution of 7 the State of Hawaii, is attached to the judiciary branch for 8 purposes of administration.

9 Article VI, section 4, of the Constitution of the State of
10 Hawaii requires that the legislature provide for the staff and
11 operating expenses of the judicial selection commission in a
12 separate budget.

13 The purpose of the Act is to appropriate funds for the 14 judicial selection commission's operations for fiscal years 15 2011-2012 and 2012-2013.

16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$120,000 or so much 18 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 and the SB LRB 11-1461.doc

4	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the judicial
5	selection commission for the purposes of this Act.
