A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Lake Wilson, Hawaii's largest reservoir, could 2 potentially provide the water needed for the North Shore's 3 agricultural expansion. However, the inflow of treated 4 effluence into the lake has led to poor water quality and 5 limited agricultural production on the North Shore. Improving 6 the water quality in the lake would allow not only the expansion 7 of agricultural production, but greater recreational use of the 8 The legislature finds that the importance of the lake. agricultural industry in the area affected by Lake Wilson makes 9 10 this issue a matter of statewide significance.

11 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of 12 land and natural resources to develop a plan for the improvement 13 of the water quality in Lake Wilson.

SECTION 2. The department of land and natural resources shall develop an agricultural use development plan to assess potential methods of improving the water quality of Lake Wilson. Specifically, the agricultural use development plan shall

11	including	any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later
12	than twen	ty days prior to the convening of the regular session
13	of 2012.	
14	SECT	ION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
15	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$300,000 or so much	
16	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 for the	
17	purposes of this Act.	
18	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of	
19	land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.	
20	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
