A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IRRIGATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. A reliable irrigation system is the lifeblood
of Hawaii's agricultural industry. To ensure that Hawaii's
crops receive a steady and dependable supply of water,
sufficient funding is needed to maintain and improve Hawaii's
irrigation systems.

6 The purpose of this Act is to provide additional funding 7 needed for the repair and maintenance of irrigation systems 8 throughout the State, including additional personnel for the 9 department of agriculture to improve oversight and management of 10 the irrigation systems.

SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue general obligation bonds in the sum of \$400,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2011-2012 to be deposited into the irrigation repair and maintenance special fund and used for the purposes specified in section 3 of this Act.
