## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 269-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b) The public utilities commission [may] shall consider
4	the need [ <del>for</del> ] to reduce the State's reliance on fossil fuels
5	through energy efficiency and increased renewable energy [use]
6	generation in exercising its authority and duties under this
7	chapter. In making determinations of the reasonableness of the
8	costs of utility system capital improvements and operations, the
9	commission shall explicitly consider, quantitatively or
10	qualitatively, the fact that the State's reliance on fossil
11	fuels results in increased price volatility, export of funds for
12	fuel imports, fuel supply reliability risk, and greenhouse gas
13	emissions. The commission may determine that short-term costs
14	or direct costs that are higher than alternatives relying more
15	heavily on fossil fuels are reasonable, considering the impacts
16	resulting from the use of fossil fuels."
17	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
