Section 604-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: 3 "(c) A summons or other writ issued by a district court 4 may be served anywhere within the State. A summons or other 5 writ issued by a district court may be served without the State in accordance with [sections] section 634-24 [and], 634-25[-,], 6 7 634-34, 634-35, or 634-36." 8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
