### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF INFORMATION PRACTICES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 92-1.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

"[+]§92-1.5[+] Administration of this part. (a) 3 The 4 director of the office of information practices shall administer 5 this part. The director shall establish procedures for filing 6 and responding to complaints filed by any person concerning the 7 failure of any board to comply with this part. The director of 8 the office of information practices shall submit an annual 9 report of these complaints along with final resolution of 10 complaints, and other statistical data to the legislature, no 11 later than twenty days prior to the convening of each regular 12 session.

(b) There is created in the office of information
practices for administrative purposes, a board of information
practices composed of nine members who shall be appointed
notwithstanding the requirements of section 26-34 as follows:
(1) Three members shall be appointed by the governor;



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1	(2)	One member shall be appointed by the president of the
2		senate;
3	(3)	One member shall be appointed by the speaker of the
4		house of representatives; and
5	(4)	One member shall be appointed, subject to the approval
6		of the council of the respective county or city and
7		county, by each of:
8		(A) The mayor of the county of Hawaii;
9		(B) The mayor of the city and county of Honolulu;
10		(C) The mayor of the county of Kauai; and
11		(D) The mayor of the county of Maui.
12	Vacancies	in these positions shall be filled in the same manner.
13	The term	of each member of the board of information practices
14	shall be	three years. Members of the board of information
15	practices	shall be entitled to reimbursement for reasonable
16	travel ex	penses incurred in the course of their official duties.
17	The board	of information practices shall determine its internal
18	rules of	procedure. The office of information practices shall
19	provide a	dministrative support to the board of information
20	practices	<u>-</u>
21	(c)	The director of the office of information practices
22	shall pro	vide a reasonable opportunity for the board to comment
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1	on proposals and reports produced or distributed by the director		
2	of information practices on matters including proposed		
3	administrative rules, budgets, and proposed legislation. The		
4	board shall perform other functions as required by law or by		
5	administrative rule adopted by the director of the office of		
6	information practices pursuant to chapter 91."		
7.	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
8	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.		
9	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
