1	SECTION 1. Act 125, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008, is
2	amended by amending section 4 to read as follows:
3	"SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval[+
4	provided that the amendments made to section 302A-804, Hawaii
5	Revised Statutes, under section 2 of this Act shall be repealed
6	on July 1, 2011, and section 302A-804, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
7	shall be reenacted in the form in which it read on the day prior
8	to the effective date of this Act]."
9	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10	and stricken.
11	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

### Report Title:

DOE; Emergency Hires; Teacher Licensure Requirements

#### Description:

Makes permanent statutory provisions that: (1) reduced the maximum employment period for teachers hired on an emergency basis by DOE from 4 years to 3 years; and (2) require those unlicensed teachers hired on an emergency basis prior to 7/1/08, to attain licensure within 4 years from the date of employment. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)
