BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 711, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
and to read as follows:

4 Unlawful protest at a funeral. (1) A person "§711-5 commits the offense of unlawful protest at a funeral if that 6 person engages in picketing or other protest activities within 7 three hundred feet of any residence, cemetery, funeral home, 8 church, synagogue, mosque, or other establishment during, within 9 one hour before the start of, or within one hour after the completion of a funeral, burial service, or memorial service 10 11 conducted at the subject location. 12 (2)For purposes of this section, "picketing or other 13 protest activities" means a congregation of individuals for the 14 purpose of drawing attention through visual or audible means 15 that is disruptive to or that is undertaken with the purpose of 16 disrupting or disturbing a funeral, burial service, or memorial 17 service.

18 (3) Unlawful protest at a funeral is a misdemeanor." 2011-0615 SB SMA.doc
