A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE COUPLES ON THE BRINK PROJECT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The University of Minnesota recently began to 2 offer divorce reconciliation services to couples considering 3 dissolving their marriages. The program is offered pursuant to 4 statutory enactment, entitled "Minnesota couples on the brink 5 project". The new project allows couples an "offramp" if they 6 find themselves on the road to divorce, by offering short-term 7 coaching on a voluntary basis to help the husband and wife 8 decide whether they really want to split. If a couple decides 9 to rebuild the marriage, the project will help craft a 10 reconciliation plan. The intent of the project is to facilitate 11 reconciliation rather than divorce.

12 The legislature finds that a similar program should be 13 established in Hawaii to offer reconciliation opportunities for 14 couples considering divorce.

15 The purpose of this Act is to:

16 (1) Establish a couples on the brink project under the17 University of Hawaii; and

3	SECT	ION 2. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
4	amended by	y adding two new sections to be appropriately	
5	designated and to read as follows:		
6	" <u>§</u> 304	4A-A Hawaii couples on the brink project. (a) There	
7	is established the Hawaii couples on the brink project under the		
8	University of Hawaii for administrative purposes. Within the		
9	availability of funding, the board of regents shall develop and		
10	implement a Hawaii couples on the brink project as provided in		
11	subsection (b). The project shall be funded from deposits into		
12	the Hawaii couples on the brink project special fund,		
13	establishe	ed under section 304A-B.	
14	(b)	The Hawaii couples on the brink project shall:	
15	(1)	Develop, evaluate, and disseminate best practices for	
16		promoting successful reconciliation between married	
17		persons who are considering divorce or who have	
18		commenced divorce proceedings and who choose to pursue	
19		reconciliation; and	
20	(2)	Provide counseling services consistent with paragraph	
21		(1); provided that counseling services may be offered	
22		through a contract with qualified persons or entities.	
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1 (C) The University of Hawaii shall report annually to the 2 legislature on the progress of the Hawaii couples on the brink 3 project, including the number of couples served and the number 4 of reconciled couples. 5 §304A-B Hawaii couples on the brink project special fund. 6 There is established a Hawaii couples on the brink project 7 special fund, to be administered by the University of Hawaii. 8 The purpose of the fund shall be to facilitate the Hawaii 9 couples on the brink project under section 304A-A. 10 Moneys collected from a portion of the marriage license fee 11 under section 572-5 shall be deposited into the Hawaii couples 12 on the brink project special fund. All expenditures from the 13 fund shall be subject to legislative appropriation." 14 SECTION 3. Section 572-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 15 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows: 16 The department of health shall appoint, and at its "(a) 17 pleasure remove, one or more suitable persons as agents 18 authorized to grant marriage licenses under this chapter in each 19 judicial circuit. The agents may issue licenses from any state 20 facility when deemed necessary by the director. Any agent 21 appointed under this subsection and receiving an application for 22 a marriage license shall collect from the applicant for the





1	license [$\frac{60}{5}$, $\frac{55}{5}$, of which the agent, except those provided	
2	for in sul	bsection (b), shall retain \$9 for the agent's benefit	
3	and compe	nsation and shall remit [$\$51$] $\$56$ to the director of

6	(1)	\$32 for each license issued to the credit of the	
7		general fund of the State;	
8	(2)	\$4.50 for each license issued to the credit of the	
9		spouse and child abuse special account established	
10		under section 346-7.5;	
11	(3)	\$4.50 for each license issued to the credit of the	
12		spouse and child abuse special account established	
13		under section 601-3.6; [and]	
14	(4)	\$10 for each license issued to the credit of the birth	
15		defects special fund established under section	
16		321-426[-] <u>; and</u>	
17	(5)	\$5 for each license issued to the credit of the Hawaii	
18		couples on the brink project special fund established	
19		under section 304A-B.	
20	(b)	The department may appoint, as regular employees under	
21	the civil	service and classification laws, the number of	
22	suitable persons as agents authorized to grant marriage licenses		
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1	for whom	provision has been made in the general appropriation	
2	act. In	the case of these agents, the full amount collected	
3	from appl	icants shall be remitted to the director of health.	
4	Upon the	receipt of remittances under this subsection, the	
.5	director	of health shall deposit:	
6	(1)	\$41 for each license issued to the credit of the	
7		general fund of the State;	
8	(2)	\$4.50 for each license issued to the credit of the	
9		spouse and child abuse special account established	
10		under section 346-7.5;	
11	(3)	\$4.50 for each license issued to the credit of the	
12		spouse and child abuse special account established	
13		under section 601-3.6; [and]	
14	(4)	\$10 for each license issued to the credit of the birth	
15		defects special fund established under section	
16		321-426[-]; and	
17	(5)	\$5 for each license issued to the credit of the Hawaii	
18		couples on the brink project special fund established	
19		under section 304A-B."	
20	SECI	ION 4. In codifying this Act the revisor shall	
21	substitut	e appropriate section numbers for the letter	
22	designations used in place of section numbers.		
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1 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the Hawaii couples 2 on the brink project special fund established under section 3 304A-B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the sum of \$ or so 4 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 5 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for 6 fiscal year 2012-2013 for purposes of the Hawaii couples on the 7 brink project under section 304A-A. 8 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the University 9 of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act. 10 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 12 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011. 13
