BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 444-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b) Of the board members:
4	(1) Ten shall be contractors who have been actively
5	engaged in the contracting business for a period of
6	not less than five years preceding the date of their
7	appointment;
8	(2) [Five] Three shall be general engineering or building
9	contractors, [five] three shall be specialty
10	contractors, three shall be exclusive representatives
11	of collective bargaining units, and [three] four shall
12	be noncontractors. No member shall receive any
13	compensation for the member's services, but each shall
14	be reimbursed for necessary traveling expenses
15	incurred in the performance of duties."
16	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
