# A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii imports most 2 of its beef, with only a small percentage of the cattle raised 3 in Hawaii being consumed within the State. The majority of locally-raised cattle are shipped to the mainland for finishing 4 5 and slaughter. The legislature has long recognized the benefits 6 of maintaining the viability of the State's beef industry for 7 local consumption in an effort to increase Hawaii's food self-8 sufficiency and overall sustainability. However, adequate 9 resources are necessary to promote ranching and increase cattle 10 production.

11 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the 12 department of agriculture to acquire a slaughterhouse within 13 Campbell Industrial Park on the island of Oahu and to make 14 necessary capital improvements thereto.

15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,600,000 or so much 17 thereof as may be necessary for the fiscal year 2011-2012 for 18 the department of agriculture to:
