A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ANIMAL INDUSTRY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 142, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§142-</u> Animal industry special fund. There is
5	established the animal industry special fund to be administered
6	by the board of agriculture. All moneys received by the board
7	of agriculture from:
8	(1) Moneys received for the use or rental of the division
9	of animal industry's properties or facilities,
10	including the animal quarantine property or facilities
11	pursuant to section 142-3.5; or
12	(2) Appropriations or other moneys made available,
13	shall be deposited into the special fund. All interest earned
14	or accrued on moneys deposited in the special fund shall become
15	part of the special fund. Moneys in the special fund shall be
16	expended to cover costs of the division of animal industry,
17	including the costs of salaries, fringe benefits, operating
18	expenses, equipment, motor vehicles, contract with any qualified
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1	person or entity for livestock handling services, and operating
2	and maintenance of the animal industry facilities. A reserve
3	shall be maintained in the special fund to cover contingency
4	costs, including accrued vacation leave, unemployment insurance,
5	and workers' compensation."
6	SECTION 2. Section 142-3.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
7	amended to read as follows:
8	"§142-3.5 Authority to contract or rent facilities. The
9	board of agriculture may contract with third parties for the use
10	or rental of animal quarantine property or facilities; provided
11	that:
12	(1) The board determines the property or facilities are
13	not required for use by the animal quarantine program
14	during the term of use by the third party;
15	(2) The property or facilities shall be leased or rented
16	at a reasonable lease rent as determined by the board
17	of agriculture;
18	(3) The property or facilities shall be used for animal
19	welfare, including emergency shelters for animals, or
20	[agriculture-related] other commercial purposes; and
21	(4) The property or facilities shall be used only by the
22	third party.

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1 Revenues generated by the use or rental of the division of 2 animal industry's property or facilities, including the animal 3 quarantine property or facilities, shall be [used] deposited 4 into the animal industry special fund, established pursuant to 5 section 142- , to defray the operational costs of the [animal 6 quarantine program and to minimize animal quarantine fees.] 7 department of agriculture's division of animal industry." 8 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 and 11 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 12 year 2012-2013 to be deposited into the animal industry special 13 fund, established pursuant to section 142- , Hawaii Revised 14 Statutes, to establish a reserve in the special fund to cover 15 contingency costs, including accrued vacation leave, 16 unemployment insurance, and workers' compensation. 17 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the animal industry 18 special fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be 19 necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 and the same sum or so much 20 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to be 21 expended for the purposes of this Act.

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The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
