A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ANIMAL INDUSTRY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 142, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 2 3 and to read as follows: Animal industry special fund. There is 4 "§142-5 established the animal industry special fund to be administered by the board of agriculture. All moneys received by the board 6 7 of agriculture from: 8 Moneys received for the use or rental of the division (1)9 of animal industry's properties or facilities, including the animal guarantine property or facilities 10 pursuant to section 142-3.5; or 11 12 Appropriations or other moneys made available, (2) shall be deposited into the special fund. All interest earned 13 or accrued on moneys deposited in the special fund shall become 14 part of the special fund. Moneys in the special fund shall be 15 expended to cover costs of the division of animal industry, 16 17 including the costs of salaries, fringe benefits, operating expenses, equipment, motor vehicles, contract with any qualified 18 SB281 SD2 LRB 11-2500.doc

1	person or entity for livestock handling services, and operating
2	and maintenance of the animal industry facilities; provided that
3	moneys in the special fund may also be used to fund the
4	department's resource management and planning programs. A
5	reserve shall be maintained in the special fund to cover
6	contingency costs, including accrued vacation leave,
7	unemployment insurance, and workers' compensation."
8	SECTION 2. Section 142-3.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
9	amended to read as follows:
10	"§142-3.5 Authority to contract or rent facilities. The
11	board of agriculture may contract with third parties for the use
12	or rental of animal quarantine property or facilities; provided
13	that:
14	(1) The board determines the property or facilities are
15	not required for use by the animal quarantine program
16	during the term of use by the third party;
17	(2) The property or facilities shall be leased or rented
18	at a reasonable lease rent as determined by the board
19	of agriculture;
20	(3) The property or facilities shall be used for animal
21	welfare, including emergency shelters for animals, or
22	[agriculture-related] other commercial purposes; and



The property or facilities shall be used only by the 1 (4)2 third party. 3 Revenues generated by the use or rental of the division of 4 animal industry's property or facilities, including the animal 5 quarantine property or facilities, shall be [used] deposited 6 into the animal industry special fund, established pursuant to 7 section 142- , to defray the operational costs of the [animal 8 quarantine program and to minimize animal quarantine fees.] 9 department of agriculture's division of animal industry." 10 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 and 13 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 14 year 2012-2013 to be deposited into the animal industry special 15 fund, established pursuant to section 142- , Hawaii Revised 16 Statutes, to establish a reserve in the special fund to cover 17 contingency costs, including accrued vacation leave, 18 unemployment insurance, and workers' compensation. 19 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the animal industry 20 special fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be 21 necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 and the same sum or so much



1	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to be
2	expended for the purposes of this Act.
3	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
4	of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
5	SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
6	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
7	SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
