BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 421J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: Notice required. (a) Not less than fourteen 4 "§421Jdays in advance of any meeting of an association or of the board 5 6 of directors, the secretary or other officer specified in the 7 bylaws shall give written notice of the meeting to each member of the association as provided in the bylaws of the association 8 9 or by one or more of the following means: 10 (1) Hand delivery; (2) United States mail sent to the mailing address of each 11 12 unit or to another mailing address designated in 13 writing by the association member; 14 (3) Electronic mail to the electronic mailing address 15 designated in writing by the association member; or 16 (4)Posting of the meeting notice in its entirety on a 17 portion of the association's website that is 18 accessible to all members.

2	(1)	The date, time, and place of the meeting; and
3)	(2)	The items on the agenda, including the general nature
4		of and rationale for any proposed amendment to the
5		declaration or bylaws and any proposal to remove a
6		member of the board.
7	(c)	The requirements of this section shall not be
8	interpret	ed to preclude any association member from proposing an
9	amendment	to the declaration or bylaws or proposing to remove a
10	member of	the board at an association meeting."
