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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 353C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§353C- Correctional facility and community correctional
5	center deaths; reporting. (a) The director shall report to the
6	governor, and the governor shall report to the legislature, the
7	death of:
8	(1) Correctional facility or community correctional center
9	employees who die on the grounds of a correctional
10	facility or community correctional center where Hawaii
11	inmates reside or who sustain an injury on the grounds
12	of a correctional facility or community correctional
13	center where Hawaii inmates reside that causes the
14	death of the employee; and
15	(2) Any Hawaii inmate who is incarcerated in a

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1	(b)	The report in subsection (a) shall include the
2	following	information:
3	(1)	The name of the decedent;
4	(2)	Whether the decedent was an inmate or employee;
5	<u>(3)</u>	The location of the death or injury leading to the

7	(4)	The date and time of the death; and
8	(5)	The cause of death;
9	provided	that if the cause of death has not been officially
10	determine	d, the director shall provide notice of the official
11	cause of	death as required by this section within forty-eight
12	hours of :	receipt of that information.
13	(c)	The director shall have the discretion to withhold
14	disclosur	e of the decedent's name pending notification of the
15	death to	the next of kin or if the decedent's identity is
16	protected	from disclosure by state or federal laws."
