RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 302A-802, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "§302A-802 Licensing standards; policies. (a) The board
4 shall establish licensing standards that govern teacher
5 licensing in Hawaii. Licensing standards established by the
6 board shall be adopted as rules under chapter 91 unless
7 otherwise specified in this subpart.

8 (b) In the development of its standards, the board shall 9 consider the existing teacher applicant pool that is available 10 in the State and the level of the qualification of these 11 applicants, as well as the nature and availability of existing 12 preservice higher education teacher training programs.

Teacher Licenses; Vocational, Technical, Career Pathway Teachers

Description:

Requires HTSB to develop criteria for the issuance of vocational, technical, and career pathway (VTC) teaching permits and licenses. Requires DOE to waive the bachelor's degree requirement for VTC teachers and issue special permits or licenses under certain conditions. Sets forth certain privileges for teachers who receive VTC teaching licenses.
