BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 103D-408, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:

3 "[+]§103D-408[+] [Indigenous] Native Hawaiian and Polynesian introduced plants; use in public landscaping. 4 (a) 5 [Wherever and whenever feasible, all] All plans, designs, and 6 specifications for new or renovated landscaping of any building, 7 complex of buildings, facility, complex of facilities, [or] 8 housing, or highway and road construction and improvement 9 projects developed by the State with public moneys shall 10 incorporate [indigenous land plant species as defined in section 11 195D 2, and plant species brought to Hawaii by Polynesians 12 before European contact, such as the kukui, noni, and coconut;] 13 native Hawaiian land plants; provided that: 14 (1)Suitable cultivated plants can be made available for 15 this purpose without jeopardizing wild plants in their
