BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 514B-123, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows: 3 "(d) A proxy, to be valid, shall: Be delivered to the secretary of the association or 4 (1)5 the managing agent, if any, no later than 4:30 p.m. on 6 the second business day prior to the date of the 7 meeting to which it pertains; 8 (2) Contain at least the name of the association, the date 9 of the meeting of the association, the printed names 10 and signatures of the persons giving the proxy, the 11 unit numbers for which the proxy is given, the names 12 of persons to whom the proxy is given, and the date 13 that the proxy is given; and 14 . (3) If it is a standard proxy form authorized by the 15 association, contain boxes wherein the owner has 16 indicated that the proxy is given: **17** For quorum purposes only; or
