RELATING TO THE HAWAII HEALTH SYSTEMS CORPORATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. (a) No later than January 1, 2012, the board
 of directors of the Hawaii health systems corporation shall
 develop an action plan for converting the Hawaii health systems
 corporation into a private nonprofit tax-exempt organization by
 July 1, 2012.

- 10 (2) Identification of effective corporate governance and

- 14 (4) Estimated conversion and re-capitalization costs and15 strategies for financing;
- 16 (5) Development of a detailed business plan, including pro
 17 forma financials and cash flow;
