### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NATUROPATHIC MEDICINE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 455, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: "§455- Controlled substances; authorization. 4 Subject to 5 any requirements imposed by the department of public safety and the federal Drug Enforcement Administration, a naturopathic 6 7 physician may register with the department of public safety pursuant to section 329-33 and may obtain a current Federal Drug 8 9 Enforcement Administration registration." SECTION 2. Section 329-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 10 amended by amending the definition of "practitioner" to read as 11 12 follows: 13 "Practitioner" means: A physician, dentist, veterinarian, scientific 14 (1)investigator, or other person licensed and registered 15

under section 329-32 to distribute, dispense, or

conduct research with respect to a controlled
