BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that public disclosure of
 incomes of elected officials enhances public trust because the
 disclosure tends to reduce real and perceived conflicts of
 interest.

5 The purpose of this Act is to require legislators to 6 disclose any source of annual income derived from a single 7 source that is \$25,000 or more, or that represents twenty-five 8 per cent or more of the total annual income received from all 9 sources other than the legislative salaries, if that source has 10 an interest in the outcome of legislation.

SECTION 2. Chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

14 "<u>\$84-</u> Additional requirements of disclosure; legislator.
15 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, and in addition
16 to requirements for disclosure for legislators pursuant to
17 section 84-17, a legislator shall disclose every source of
18 annual income derived from a single source that is \$25,000 or

1 more, or that represents an amount equal to twenty-five per cent
2 or more of the legislator's total annual income from all
3 sources, excluding legislative salary, if that source has an
4 interest in the outcome of legislation."
5 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
