A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NEPOTISM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
by adding three new sections to be appropriately designated and
to read as follows:
"\$84-A Nepotism prohibited. No legislator or employee, by

5 virtue of the legislator or employee's public office or

6 employment, shall appoint, confirm the appointment of, or vote

7 for the appointment or confirmation of the appointment of an

8 individual to a position that is to be directly or indirectly

9 compensated from public funds or fees if the individual is

10 related to the legislator or employee within the third degree of

- 11 consanguinity or by affinity.
- 12 §84-B Consanguinity, determination. (a) Two individuals
- 13 are related to each other by consanguinity if:
- 14 (1) One is a descendant of the other; or
- 15 (2) They share a common ancestor.
- 16 An adopted child is considered to be a child of the
- 17 adoptive parent for the purpose of consanguinity.



1	(b)	The degree of relationship by consanguinity between an
2	individua	l and the individual's descendant is determined by the
3	number of	generations that separate them. A parent and child
4	are relate	ed in the first degree, a grandparent and grandchild in
5	the second	d degree, a great-grandparent and great-grandchild in
6	the third	degree and so on.
7	(c)	If an individual and the individual's relative are
8	related by	y consanguinity, but neither is descended from the
9	other, the	e degree of relationship is determined by adding:
10	(1)	The number of generations between the individual and
11		the nearest common ancestor of the individual and the
12		individual's relative; and
13	(2)	The number of generations between the relative and the
14		nearest common ancestor.
15	(d)	An individual's relatives within the third degree by
16	consangui	nity are the individual's:
17	(1)	Parent or child (relatives in the first degree);
18	(2)	Brother, sister, grandparent, or grandchild (relatives
19		in the second degree); and
20	(3)	Great-grandparent, great-grandchild, aunt who is a
21		sister of a parent of the individual, uncle who is a
22		brother of a parent of the individual, nephew who is a

2		niece who is a child of a brother or sister of the

5	related t	o each other by affinity if:
6	(1)	They are married to each other;
7	(2)	The spouse of one of the individuals is related by
8		consanguinity to the other individual;
9	(3)	They are parties to a reciprocal beneficiary
10	•	relationship;
11	(4)	They reside in the same household at the time of the
12		act of nepotism, as set forth in section 84-A; or
13	(5)	They have a hanai relationship; provided that two
14		individuals have a hanai relationship if they are not
15		blood relatives and if one of them performed a
16		substantial role in the upbringing or material support
17		of the other, as attested to by the written or oral
18		designation by one of them or the relatives of one of
19		them.
20	(b)	The ending of a marriage by divorce or the death of a
21	spouse en	ds relationships by affinity created by that marriage
22	unless a	child of that marriage is living, in which case the

3	SECTION 2. In codifying the new sections added by
4	section 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
5	appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
6	the new sections in this Act.
7	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
8	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
