### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONFLICTS OF INTERESTS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 84-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
"(a) No employee shall take any official action directly
