A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to article 10A to be 3 appropriately designated and to read as follows: 4 "§431:10A- School required physician visit coverage. 5 Each policy of accident and health or sickness insurance 6 providing coverage for health care, except for policies that 7 only provide coverage for specified diseases or other limited 8 benefit coverage, shall provide coverage for an annual medical 9 examination, including the administration of any required 10 immunizations, for each child of an insured who is required by a 11 school in the State to submit a report of a medical examination, 12 including evidence of any required immunizations, to the school 13 at the start of each school year." 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 432, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 15 amended by adding a new section to part VI of article 1 to be 16 appropriately designated and to read as follows: 17 School required physician visit coverage. 7	SECTION 3. Section 432D-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8	amended to read as follows:
9	"§432D-23 Required provisions and benefits.
10	Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, each
11	policy, contract, plan, or agreement issued in the [state] State
12	after January 1, 1995, by health maintenance organizations
13	pursuant to this chapter, shall include benefits provided in
14	sections 431:10-212, 431:10A-115, 431:10A-115.5, 431:10A-116,
15	431:10A-116.5, 431:10A-116.6, 431:10A-119, 431:10A-120,
16	431:10A-121, 431:10A-125, 431:10A-126, [and] 431:10A-122, and
17	<u>431:10A-</u> , and chapter 431M."
18	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
19	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



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SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon approval and
shall apply to policies, contracts, and plans of health
insurance issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2012.
