BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 431, article 10A, Hawaii Revised
 Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to part I be
 appropriately designated and to read as follows:

16	pain. Each policy of group and blanket disability insurance

5	SECTION 3. Chapter 432, article I, Hawaii Revised
6	Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately
7	designated and to read as follows:
8	" <u>§432:1-</u> Coverage for physical therapy for chronic
9	pain. All individual and group hospital and medical service
10	plan contracts shall provide, to the extent provided under
11	section 431:10A- , coverage for physical therapy prescribed by
12	a board-certified surgeon for chronic pain."
13	SECTION 4. Section 432D-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	"§432D-23 Required provisions and benefits.
16	Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, each
17	policy, contract, plan, or agreement issued in the State after
18	January 1, 1995, by health maintenance organizations pursuant to
19	this chapter, shall include benefits provided in sections

3 SECTION 5. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
5 begun before its effective date.

Physical Therapy; Mandated Coverage

Description:

Requires health insurance policies and related products to cover physical therapy prescribed by a board-certified surgeon for chronic pain.

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
