A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that county neighborhood SECTION 1. 2 boards have very competitive elections with many candidates 3 receiving campaign contributions to finance their election. The 4 legislature is concerned about possible undue interest group 5 influence in the neighborhood board elections, in view of the current practice of mailing out newsletters, brochures, or door 6 7 flyers to promote a candidate.

8 The legislature further finds that campaign contributions 9 used by candidates for neighborhood boards to finance the 10 printing and mailing of campaign materials should be disclosed.

11 The purpose of this Act is to:

12 (1) Repeal the exclusion of county neighborhoods boards
13 from the election campaign contributions and
14 expenditures law; and

15 (2) Require an organizational report to be filed with the
 16 campaign spending commission by any neighborhood board
 17 candidate who receives contributions or makes
