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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY CONTROL.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the office of
2	environmental quality control is greatly understaffed, and, as a
3	result, struggles to fulfill its duty to ensure environmental
4	protection in Hawaii.
5	The purpose of this Act is to:
6	(1) Establish fees to help fund the activities of the
7	office of environmental quality control;
8	(2) Hire adequate staff;
9	(3) Support outreach, training, education, and research;
10	(4) Modernize and maintain technology systems; and
11	(5) Develop technology training.
12	SECTION 2. Chapter 341, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13	amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately
14	designated and to read as follows:
15	"§341-A Environmental review special fund; use of funds.
16	(a) There is established in the state treasury the
17	environmental review special fund, into which shall be

3	(2)	Moneys collected pursuant to section 341-B;
4	(3)	All accrued interest from the special fund; and
5	(4)	Moneys appropriated to the special fund by the

9	(1)	Fund the activities of the office and the council in
10		fulfillment of their duties pursuant to this chapter
11		and chapter 343, including administrative, staffing,

13		relating to the environmental review process; provided
14		that the director may appoint personnel exempt from
15		chapters 76 and 89;
16	(2)	Support outreach, training, education, and research
17		programs pursuant to section 341-4; and
18	<u>(3)</u>	Modernize technology, maintain technology systems, and
19		develop technology training programs.
20	<u>§</u> 341	-B Fees. (a) The office may collect filing fees from
21	all appli	cants, including state and county agencies, required to

4	SECTION 3. In codifying the new sections added by section
5	2 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
6	appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
7	the new sections in this Act.
8	SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
9	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050;
10	provided that the filing fees established under this Act shall
11	not take effect until thirty days after the enactment of this
12	Act; provided further that any environmental studies filed with
13	the office of environmental quality control prior to the
14	enactment of this Act shall be exempt from the payment of any
15	filing fees under section 341-B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for
16	one hundred eighty days from the date of the enactment of this
17	Act.
