## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF ENVIRONMENTAL OUALITY CONTROL.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the office of 2 environmental quality control is greatly understaffed, and, as a result, struggles to fulfill its duty to ensure environmental 3 4 protection in Hawaii. 5 The purpose of this Act is to establish fees to help fund 6 the activities of the office of environmental quality control. 7 SECTION 2. Chapter 341, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 8 amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately 9 designated and to read as follows: 10 "§341-A Environmental review special fund; use of funds. 11 There is established in the state treasury the 12 environmental review special fund, into which shall be 13 deposited: 14 (1) All filing fees and other administrative fees
- 16 (2) Moneys collected pursuant to section 341-B;
