# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSE, ENERGY, AND FOOD SECURITY TAX.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 243-3.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 In addition to any other taxes provided by law, "(a) 4 subject to the exemptions set forth in section 243-7, there is 5 hereby imposed a state environmental response, energy, and food 6 security tax on each barrel or fractional part of a barrel of 7 petroleum product sold by a distributor to any retail dealer or end user of petroleum product, other than a refiner. The tax 8 9 shall be \$1.05 on each barrel or fractional part of a barrel of 10 petroleum product that is not aviation fuel; provided that of the tax collected pursuant to this subsection: 11

12 (1) 5 cents of the tax on each barrel shall be deposited 13 into the environmental response revolving fund 14 established under section 128D-2;

(2) [15] 44 cents of the tax on each barrel shall be
deposited into the energy security special fund
established under section 201-12.8;

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### Report Title:

Environmental Response, Energy, and Food Security Tax; Energy Security Special Fund; Agricultural Development and Food Security Special Fund

#### Description:

Requires 44 cents of the environmental response, energy, and food security tax to be deposited into the energy security special fund, 44 cents of the tax to be deposited into the agricultural development and food security special fund, and 2 cents of the tax to go toward funding the climate change task force. (SD1)
