BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 147, part I, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
is amended as follows:

3 1. By adding a new section to be appropriately designated4 and to read:

5 "§147- Carbon monoxide- or gas-treated raw fish; sales 6 prohibited. (a) No person shall sell raw fish that has been 7 treated with carbon monoxide or other gas to preserve the color or texture of the raw fish to give the appearance of freshness. 8 9 Notwithstanding section 147-2, any person who violates (b) 10 this section shall be subject to an administrative penalty of 11 \$1,000 for each offense. Each sale of raw fish in violation of this section shall constitute a separate offense. Any action 12 13 taken to impose or collect the penalty shall be considered a 14 civil action." 15 2. By amending its title to read:

16 "PART I. FRESH FRUITS, VEGETABLES, NUTS, HONEY, [and] COFFEE,
