## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SOLID WASTE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to clarify that the
2	solid waste management surcharge applies to all solid waste
3	disposal facilities that receive solid waste for ultimate
4	disposal through landfilling or incineration, whether the waste
5	is disposed of in-state or transferred out-of-state.
6	SECTION 2. Section 342G-62, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
7	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
8	"(a) There is established a solid waste management
9	surcharge. The solid waste management surcharge shall be $[\frac{35}{2}]$
10	75 cents per ton of solid waste [disposed] that is:
11	(1) Disposed of within the State at permitted or
12	unpermitted solid waste disposal facilities $[-]$ and
13	incineration facilities; or
14	(2) Transferred to solid waste reduction facilities within
15	the State that collect solid waste for transport to an
16	out-of-state landfill or incineration facility.
17	The surcharge shall be paid by the person or entity doing the
18	disposal[-] or the person or entity responsible for the



- 1 preparation of the out-of-state transfer of collected solid
- 2 waste. The owner or operator of the facility shall transfer all
- 3 moneys collected from the surcharge to the department through a
- 4 quarterly reporting and payment schedule. Estimates of
- 5 quarterly solid waste disposal shall be submitted prior to the
- 6 first day of each quarter and the transfer of moneys collected
- 7 shall occur within thirty days of the end of each quarter."
- 8 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.

## Report Title:

Solid Waste; Disposal Surcharge

## Description:

Increases the solid waste management surcharge to 75 cents per ton of solid waste. Applies the solid waste management surcharge to waste that is deposed of at landfills or incineration facilities, whether the waste is disposed of instate or transferred out-of-state. Effective July 1, 2011. (SB725 HD1)
