## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SMALL BUSINESS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii compliance 2 express is an electronic system that allows vendors doing 3 business with state or county agencies to quickly and easily 4 obtain proof that they are compliant with applicable laws. 5 Hawaii compliance express expedites a vendor's ability to 6 furnish proof of compliance with the requirements of section 7 103D-310(c), Hawaii Revised Statutes, by providing an online 8 "Certificate of Vendor Compliance" for the business entity. 9 This single certificate eliminates the need to obtain individual 10 hard copies of certificates from the Internal Revenue Service 11 and department of taxation, department of labor and industrial 12 relations, and department of commerce and consumer affairs. The 13 service includes real time monitoring of the vendor's status of 14 compliance with each agency and automatically notifies the vendor by email any time the compliance status is changed. 15 The Hawaii compliance express was launched in September 16 17 2005, and has grown from one hundred seventy-nine vendors the first year to forty-one hundred seventeen vendors through mid-18 SB758 HD1 HMS 2011-3056

December 2010. The department of accounting and general
services accounting division estimates that approximately
seventy per cent of invoices processed for payment through their
office use the Hawaii compliance express certificate, versus the
three paper certificates. The minimal cost to a vendor to use
the Hawaii compliance express is \$12 per year, a decrease from
\$15 when the system was launched in 2005.

8 In 2010, the senate committee on economic development and 9 technology and the house committee on economic revitalization, 10 business, and military affairs convened an informal small 11 business discussion group to address the most critical issues 12 facing the small business sectors within Hawaii's economy. 13 Representatives from the Chamber of Commerce of Hawaii, 14 construction and trades industries, community nonprofit 15 organizations, the agricultural sector, food and restaurant 16 industries, retailing, the science and technology sector, the 17 commercial transportation industry, and interested stakeholders 18 developed a package of bills that addresses the most pressing 19 problems facing Hawaii's small business community.

20 The purpose of this Act is to support the findings of the 21 small business working group and recommendations to extend the 22 use of Hawaii compliance express for small business vendors,

affording them the same savings of time and money in the
contracting process.

3 SECTION 2. Section 103D-310, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 4 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: 5 "(c) All offerors, upon award of contract, shall comply 6 with all laws governing entities doing business in the State, - 7 including chapters 237, 383, 386, 392, and 393. Offerors shall 8 produce documents to the procuring officer to demonstrate 9 compliance with this subsection. Any offeror making a false 10 affirmation or certification under this subsection shall be 11 suspended from further offerings or awards pursuant to section 12 103D-702. The procuring officer shall verify compliance with 13 this subsection for all contracts awarded pursuant to sections 14 103D-302, 103D-303, 103D-304, and 103D-306[+], and for 15 procurements of \$2,500 or more awarded pursuant to section 103D-16 305; provided that the attorney general may waive the 17 requirements of this subsection for contracts for legal services 18 if the attorney general certifies in writing that comparable 19 legal services are not available in this State."

20 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed21 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

22 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112.
