A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT BENEFITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 88, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
read as follows:

4 "§88- Public employees; forfeiture of benefits;

5 conviction of felony. (a) In addition to any other penalties,

6 whenever a court sentences a public employee for a felony

7 offense and the public employee's conduct constituting the

8 violation is related to the public employee's duties, the court

9 shall order the board to withhold all or a portion of the public

10 employee's benefits under this chapter, and the public

11 employee's benefits or a portion thereof shall be forfeited to

12 the credit of the pension accumulation fund.

13 (b) If the felony conviction that results in the

14 forfeiture of all or a portion of a public employee's benefits

15 pursuant to subsection (a) is overturned on appeal, the public

16 employee shall receive back benefits and be returned to the

- 17 benefits the public employee received prior to conviction.

1	(1)	"Public employee" means any public employee of the
2		State or any county, and the political subdivisions
3		and agencies thereof, any civil service or elected
4		employees or officers, and any probationary or
5		provisional employees of the State or county;
6	(2)	Employees covered by chapter 89 shall be entitled to a
7		grievance procedure culminating in a final and binding
8		decision; and
9	(3)	A rebuttable presumption shall arise that the criminal
10		conviction is just and proper cause for the employee's
11		forfeiture of benefits under this chapter."
12	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that	
13	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were	
14	begun before its effective date.	
15	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.	
16	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval	
17	and upon ratification of a constitutional amendment requiring a	
18	court to order the board of trustees of the employees'	
19	retirement system to withhold all or a portion of a public	
20	employee's benefits when that court sentences that public
