## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the seawall that
- 2 runs parallel to the shore from 2957 Kalakaua avenue to Coconut
- 3 avenue in Waikiki, Oahu, has deteriorated extensively over the
- 4 years. This has resulted in a safety hazard for residents and
- 5 visitors alike. It is critical that funds be appropriated and
- 6 expended to repair the numerous holes and breaks in the seawall
- 7 to prevent injuries and protect the public who access the ocean
- 8 at the seawall.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to make
- 10 necessary repairs to the seawall that runs parallel to the shore
- 11 from 2957 Kalakaua avenue to Coconut avenue in Waikiki, Oahu.
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$4,000,000 or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 for
- 15 repairs to the seawall that runs parallel to the shore from 2957
- 16 Kalakaua avenue to Coconut avenue in Waikiki, Oahu.
- 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 18 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
