BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 514E-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "\$514E-5 Geographic limitations. (a) Except as provided
4 in this section, time share units, time share plans, and
5 transient vacation rentals are prohibited.

[(1)] (b) Existing time share units, time share plans, and
transient vacation rentals are not impaired by the provisions of
this section.

9 [-(2)-] (c) Time share units, time share plans, and
10 transient vacation rentals are allowed:

11 [-(A)-] (1) In areas designated for hotel use, resort use, or 12 transient vacation rentals, pursuant to county 13 authority under section 46-4, or where the county, by 14 its legislative process, designates hotel, transient 15 vacation rental, or resort use; provided that if a 16 county establishes a time share zoning district that 17 allows time share units and time share plans, the 18 county may restrict time share units and time share

2	designated for hotel use, resort use, or transient
3	vacation rentals;
4	$\left[\frac{B}{2}\right]$ (2) In a hotel where the county explicitly approves
5	such use, in advance, as a nonconforming use; or
6	$\left[\frac{(C)}{(C)}\right]$ (3) In a county with a population in excess of five
7	hundred thousand, in an existing hotel which is a
8	valid nonconforming use under county ordinance."
9	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
