A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SIXTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The sixth senatorial district, encompassing the 2 islands of Moloka'i, Lana'i, and Kaho'olawe, Hana, and east and 3 upcountry Maui, is one of the "canoe" districts. Thus, each island area has vastly different capital improvement project 4 5 needs. 6 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for capital 7 improvement projects in the sixth senatorial district. SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue 8 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$78,363,000 or so much 9 10 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof 11 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2011-2012 for capital improvement projects for the sixth senatorial 12 13 district, as follows: Maui community college, Molokai campus 14 1. 15 Α. 12		15, shall be expended by the department of education;
13	(4)	The sums appropriated in items 4, 5, 8, 9, and 12,
14		shall be expended by the department of land and
15		natural resources;
16	(5)	The sum appropriated in item 10 shall be expended by
17		the department of human services; and
18	(6)	The sums appropriated in items 18 through 24 shall be
19		expended by the department of transportation.
