A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII HURRICANE RELIEF FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 431P, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
 and to read as follows:

4 "<u>\$431P- Refund of Money.</u> (a) Any owner of eligible
5 property as defined in section 431P-1 who, within ninety days
6 after the effective date of this Act, submits to the Hawaii
7 Hurricane Relief Fund proof of payment as defined in section
8 431P-1 of special mortgage recording fees as established by this
9 chapter, shall receive a full refund from the hurricane reserve
10 trust fund of those fees.

11 (b) Any owner of eligible property as defined in section 12 431P-1 who, within ninety days after the effective date of this 13 Act, submits to the Hawaii Hurricane Relief Fund proof of 14 payment as defined in section 431P-1 of the amount paid in 15 policy premiums for hurricane insurance coverage issued by the Hawaii Hurricane Relief Fund, either directly or through a 16 17 servicing carrier, shall receive a prorated refund from the 18 hurricane reserve trust fund of those premiums paid. 1	(c) The pro rata percentage in subsection (b) of this			
2	section shall be calculated as provided in this section. After			
3	the ninety day deadline for submitting refund claims has			
4	expired, and all valid claims under subsection (a) of this			
5	section have been paid, the accumulated total net income left in			
6	the hurricane reserve trust fund, less \$1,000,000, shall be			
7	distributed among the claimants as follows. If the funds			
8	available for distribution are sufficient, all persons with			
9	valid claims under subsection (b) shall be refunded the total			
10	amount claimed under subsection (b) for which proof of payment			
11	is provided. If sufficient funds are not available to refund			
12	all claimants in full, each claimant shall be assigned a			
13	percentage equal to the amount of policy premiums for which that			
14	claimant has provided proof of payment under subsection (b),			
15	divided by the total sum of policy premiums for which proof of			
16	payment has been provided by all claimants under subsection			
17	(b). Each claimant shall then be refunded that claimant's			
18	assigned percentage of the total funds available for			
19	distribution under this subsection.			
20	(d) Refunds under this section shall be issued no later			
21	than sixty days after the ninety day deadline for submission of			
22	claims established in subsections (a) and (b) of this section.
