2	temporary binder, a person shall submit proof to the insurer of
3	the person's enrollment in an approved motorcycle education
4	course. The temporary insurance binder shall be subject to

6	the course for which proof was submitted to the insurer.]
7	Liability coverage provided under subsection (a)(3) shall be in
8	the form of a temporary insurance binder issued for a period of
9	not more than one-hundred eighty days from the date of learner's
10	permit issuance to a person who has a valid motorcycle or motor
11	scooter learner's permit. If the person does not obtain a
12	license pursuant to section 286-108 within the period of
