A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO UNIFORM MAINTENANCE ALLOWANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the uniform
maintenance allowance for enlisted personnel in the Hawaii
national guard was established by Act 196, Session Laws of
Hawaii 1967, to assist them with certain expenses.

5 Subsequently, Act 197, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, increased 6 the tax exemption for enlisted personnel, which in effect, more 7 than covered any anticipated costs with respect to uniform 8 maintenance. Additionally, the legislature finds that most 9 modern military service uniforms are made of wash and wear 10 fabric that no longer requires dry cleaning. Consequently, considering the budget crisis faced by state government, the 11 uniform maintenance allowance is not warranted at this time. 12 13 The purpose of this Act is to repeal the uniform

14 maintenance allowance for enlisted personnel.

15 SECTION 2. Section 121-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 16 repealed.

8	[(b)] Enlisted personnel of the army or air national guard
9	who receive a uniform maintenance allowance from the state
10	department of defense, regardless of the source of the funds,
11	may designate a financial institution account into which the
12	department of accounting and general services is authorized to
13	deposit the member's uniform maintenance allowance."]
14	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15	and stricken.
16	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
