A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HOMELESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. To immediately implement the housing first
 program under section 346-378, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the
 department of human services shall:

4 (1) Identify state, county, and privately-owned real
5 estate properties statewide that are appropriately
6 zoned and have necessary infrastructure in place for
7 the development of affordable rental housing for low8 income individuals and families under the housing
9 first program;

10 (2)Identify and provide a feasibility and cost analysis 11 regarding an appropriate site on state, county, or 12 privately-owned real estate property that is 13 appropriately zoned and has necessary infrastructure 14 in place for the development, by new construction or 15 refurbishing, of an initial housing first program 16 model housing project that focuses on single-resident occupancy affordable rental housing; provided that the 17 18 site shall be centrally located within an urban core;



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1	(3)	Strive to locate health, social, educational, and
2		employment services on housing first program project
3		sites, where appropriate; and
4	(4)	Identify dedicated funding sources for the housing
5		first program.
6	SECT	ION 2. For purposes of section 1 of this Act, the
7	departmen	t of human services shall report its findings and
8	recommend	lations to the governor and the legislature no later
9	than December 1, 2011. The findings and recommendations shall	
10	include:	
11	(1)	The identification of each property by legal owner,
12		street location, and tax map key number;
13	(2)	The description of the existing use of each property
14		and the current zoning designation of the property;
15	(3)	Information on the value of each property and the
16		basis of the valuation;
17	(4)	An analysis of the potential for each property to
18		implement housing first programs and services; and
19	(5)	The identification of dedicated funding sources for
20		housing first programs and services.
21	SECT	ION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Description:

Requires the department of human services to locate suitable properties for a housing first program to implement affordable rental housing projects, including an initial housing first single-resident occupancy affordable rental housing model project site in an urban core. Requires DHS to report to the legislature and the governor. Effective 07/01/2050. (SD2)

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
