15	(b)	Notwithstanding subsection (a), the authority shall	
16	designate	one or more permissible smoking areas not less than

(c) For purposes of this section:
"Common areas" means those portions of the land, building,
and all appurtenances and easements that are available for use
by tenants or as designated by the authority as a common area.
"Smoking" means inhaling or exhaling the fumes of tobacco
or any other plant material or burning or carrying any lighted
smoking equipment for tobacco or any other plant material."
SECTION 2. Section 356D-92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
"(a) Except as otherwise provided, the authority may
terminate any lease, rental agreement, permit, or license
covering the use and occupation of any dwelling unit or other
premises located within a public housing project and evict from
any premises any tenant, licensee, or other occupant for any of
the following reasons:
(1) Failure to pay rent when due;
(2) Violation of any of the provisions of a lease, rental
agreement, permit, or license;

(3) Violation of any of the rules of the authority;
