#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS MADE OUT OF THE EMERGENCY AND BUDGET RESERVE FUND PURSUANT TO ACT 191, SESSION LAWS OF HAWAII 2010.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Pursuant to Act 191, Session Laws of Hawaii 2 2010, the legislature appropriated moneys from the emergency and 3 budget reserve fund to maintain levels of essential programs for 4 education, human services, health, and the public welfare. As of December 2010, the new governor is in the process of 5 6 releasing the funds appropriated pursuant to Act 191. However, 7 due to the delay in the release of funds the expending agencies 8 may not have enough time to expend the funds before they lapse 9 at the end of the 2010-2011 fiscal year, thereby severely 10 curtailing their ability to help the persons recognized by the 11 legislature as being in dire need of these essential services. 12 The purpose of this Act is to extend to December 31, 2011 13 the date on which the funds will lapse to ensure the fulfillment 14 of the legislature's intent in passing Act 191, Session Laws of 15 Hawaii 2010.

16 SECTION 2. Act 191, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, is 17 amended as follows:

There is appropriated out of the emergency 17 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of 18 \$200,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 19 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, 20 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Volunteer Legal Services Hawaii to 21 provide pro bono legal services for indigent persons.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for 2 the purposes of this Act." 3 10. By amending section 33 to read: 4 There is appropriated out of the emergency "SECTION 33. 5 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of 6 \$720,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 7 2010-2011 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, 8 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Legal Aid Society of Hawaii to 9 provide general civil legal services. 10 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for the purposes of this Act." 11 12 11. By amending section 34 to read: 13 "SECTION 34. There is appropriated out of the emergency 14 and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of 15 \$282,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 16 2010-2011 for the University of Hawaii Family Law Clinic to 17 provide services to obtain temporary restraining orders. 18 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for 19 the purposes of this Act." 20 By amending section 35 to read: 12. 21 "SECTION 35. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2 2010 [-]; provided that the appropriations made by this Act shall 3 not lapse at the end of the fiscal year for which the 4 appropriations are made; provided further that moneys from the 5 appropriations made by this Act that are unencumbered as of 6 December 31, 2011, shall lapse at the close of business on that 7 date." 8 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the emergency and 9 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$60,000 or 10 so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 to 11 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii 12 Revised Statutes, to The Path Clinic for perinatal clinical and 13 social services for women in Hawaii with past or present 14 substance abuse. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 15 16 health for the purposes of this Act. 17 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the emergency and 18 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$447,750 19 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 20 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii 21 Revised Statutes, to Hawai'i Centers for Independent Living for 22 the statewide independent living purchase of services. 2011-0274 SB SMA-2.doc

1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 2 human services for the purposes of this Act. 3 SECTION 5. The appropriations made by sections 3 and 4 of 4 this Act shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year for which 5 the appropriations are made; provided that moneys from the 6 appropriations made by sections 3 and 4 of this Act that are 7 unencumbered as of December 31, 2011, shall lapse at the close 8 of business on that date. 9 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 11 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 12
