A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the enhanced integration of technology in the classroom is one means of assisting the department of education in meeting its statewide educational goals. Implementation of a comprehensive data system would assist the department in managing its widespread network of student achievement data and educational resources in a more efficient manner.

8 The legislature further finds that the New York City 9 Department of Education has adopted the achievement reporting 10 and innovation system (ARIS), which provides teachers with 11 student achievement data and instructional resources on the same 12 information platform. ARIS is a first of its kind innovation 13 system that applies assessment, analytics, and reporting tools 14 with goals of:

15 (1) Empowering educators to improve student outcomes;
16 (2) Transforming information into improved classroom
17 practice; and



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Stimulating, capturing, validating, and disseminating 1 (3) 2 innovation. 3 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of 4 education to implement a comprehensive data system, such as 5 ARIS, to accelerate student learning. 6 SECTION 2. No later than August 2011, the department of 7 education shall implement a comprehensive data system to provide 8 educators with a consolidated view of student learning-related 9 data and tools to collaborate and share knowledge for the 10 acceleration of student learning. 11 The department shall include information on the 12 comprehensive data system and its effects on student learning in 13 its annual reports on the educational accountability system, 14 pursuant to section 302A-1004, Hawaii Revised Statutes. 15 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 and 18 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 19 year 2012-2013 for implementation and management of a 20 comprehensive data system to provide educators with a 21 consolidated view of student learning-related data and tools to



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1 collaborate and share knowledge for the acceleration of student 2 learning.

3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department of education for the purposes of this Act. 4

5 This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011. SECTION 4.
