A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY AND BUDGET RESERVE FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the national and 2 global economic crisis that began in the second half of 2008 has caused significant economic problems in numerous industries in 3 4 the State, including the airline, cruise ship, tourist, and 5 construction industries. Mass layoffs have been reported by an 6 increasing number of Hawaii businesses statewide, from the 7 agricultural sector to the medical-services sector. Difficult 8 economic times and declining tax revenues have resulted in 9 budget cuts for all state services.

10 The current and impending situation jeopardizes the safety net of basic human services, health, and education needs for 11 12 Hawaii's residents and families. While all of Hawaii's residents will be affected by the situation, gap group families 13 14 and families closest to the poverty line will suffer the most. 15 Pursuant to Act 304, Session Laws of Hawaii 1999, the 16 legislature established the emergency and budget reserve fund, 17 which is codified in section 3238L-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, 18 as a temporary supplemental source of funding for the State of 2011-1311 SB935 SD1 SMA-1.doc

1 Hawaii in times of emergency, economic downturn, or unforeseen 2 reduction in revenues. As set forth in section 328L-3, Hawaii 3 Revised Statutes, specific purposes for the fund include 4 maintaining levels of programs determined to be essential to 5 public health, safety, welfare, and education. Section 328L-3, 6 Hawaii Revised Statutes, also includes certain prohibitions on 7 appropriations from the emergency and budget reserve fund. 8 Appropriations for the following purposes are specifically 9 prohibited:

10 (1) To meet expenses of the legislature;

11 (2) To provide for salary adjustments for officials
12 appointed pursuant to article V, section 6; or article
13 VI, section 3, of the Hawaii State Constitution and
14 for others whose salaries are directly related to
15 salaries of these officials; and

16 (3) To fund cost items in any collective bargaining17 contract.

18 The legislature finds that expenditures from the emergency 19 and budget reserve fund are needed to meet the conditions of 20 emergency, economic downturn, and unforeseen reduction in 21 revenues that the State currently faces. Further, the 22 legislature finds that the appropriations in this Act are



1 consistent with the purposes of the emergency and budget reserve
2 fund.

3 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys from the
4 emergency and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii to
5 maintain the levels of programs determined to be essential to
6 education, public health, and public welfare.

7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
8 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$200,000
9 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012
10 for respite services.

11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 12 health for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the emergency and 14 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,500,000 15 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 16 to supplement the healthy start program.

17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of18 health for the purposes of this Act.

19 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the emergency and 20 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$950,000 21 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012

to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii
 Revised Statutes, to be distributed as follows:

3	(1)	Catholic Charities Hawaii	\$350,000
4	(2)	Kapahulu Center	\$300,000
5	(3)	Moiliili Community Center	\$150,000
6	(4)	Waikiki Community Center	\$150,000

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of8 health for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
10 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$3,000,000
11 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012
12 for the kupuna care program.

13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of14 health for the purposes of this Act.

15 SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the emergency and 16 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$100,000 17 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 18 for the Aging and Disability Resource Center.

19 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of20 health for the purposes of this Act.

21 SECTION 7. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
22 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,500,000



or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012
 for the developmental disabilities medicaid waiver program.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of4 health for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
6 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,500,000
7 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012
8 for mental health services.

9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of10 health for the purposes of this Act.

SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$150,000
or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012
for the partnerships in community living program.

15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 16 health for the purposes of this Act.

SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,400,000
or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012
for substance abuse treatment.

21 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of22 health for the purposes of this Act.
