A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GOVERNMENT FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of 2 accounting and general services central services division 3 repairs and alternations program is responsible for providing 4 major, minor, and emergency repair services and minor alteration 5 services for one-hundred sixty-four state office buildings and 6 facilities. Services include repairs and alterations of buildings, monitoring and regulating the air conditioning in 7 8 designated buildings, managing contracts for elevators and air 9 conditioning maintenance, and oversight of the work performed by 10 contracted service providers. In addition, the department's 11 public works division planning, design, and construction program 12 provides a full range of planning, design, and construction management services for all agencies of the executive branch and 13 14 for others upon request.

In meeting the mandates of these programs, the department faces increasing costs of energy consumption, health and safety requirements, natural disasters, energy-efficiency projects, and the challenges that budget cuts and furloughs have placed on the 2011-0404 SB SMA.doc

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department's ability to manage its resources more efficiently
and minimize a backlog of requests for services.

The purpose of this Act is to provide the department with additional sources of funds to support the department's mission to establish and maintain a clean, safe, and pleasant building work environment; maintain safe and aesthetically pleasing grounds at state buildings and facilities; and provide timely, quality, cost-effective, and innovative repair and alteration services for public buildings and facilities statewide.

10 SECTION 2. Section 107-1.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

12 "(b) The comptroller shall make [reasonable] assessments 13 on construction projects managed by the department of accounting 14 and general services to carry out the program of centralized 15 engineering services. The assessments shall be [based on a 16 logarithmic curve developed by the department for such 17 services.] per cent of all state fund appropriations for 18 capital improvements designated for the construction cost 19 element; provided that assessment moneys shall apply only to 20 capital improvement appropriations that are designated for the

21 construction or renovation of state buildings. All assessments
